Wellness Fair - was a success! 23 vendors; 121 signed in as attending; 5 Spanish speaking families; vendors ran out of stuff;

Culture Fest - was a success! Tried a Saturday this year rather than Friday as done in the past; did not break or exceed fire code this year. Stuck to gym and cafeteria; used stage for performances. Hammond STEP canceled due to illness; FRES students and Irish Dancers provided performances. There was food and even fresh coffee roasting. Looks like we came in under budget.

Staff Appreciation (Akta): PTA will celebrate in May - teacher appreciation week; May 6th - 10th

Teacher Grants Report (Pratima): \$2500 budgeted; a lot of applications; all reviewed. Approved projects for 3rd grade, 2nd, K, Special Ed, 1st, 5th, SLP, 2 individual teachers, media staff. Currently ironing out the details for disbursement of funds.

5th Grade Activities (Carrie):

- Fundraising - Art to Remember fundraiser (5th grade); Awaiting Main Event amount; will not do See's Candy fundraiser; hopefully that will be all the fundraising needed.
- SCH May 15th - Panera for food (15-20 people) - need to check cost as budget is only \$200. Decorate with flags outside and in the 5th grade hallway. Austin's music room for lunch.
- Dance 6/1 - DJ already confirmed

Student Enrichment (Mallory)

- Free StemTree in January went very well so StemStree is trying out a 6 week class on Mondays - 15 enrolled
- Little Track Stars Program five weeks in April and May
- Leap Day Frogs
- STEAM Night Support in May 30th - budgeted \$200 (donation requests to Home Depot and Lowes)
- Motion to reallocate assembly funds. We budgeted for 3 assemblies but can only do 2 due to scheduling. Motion to move \$1200 for virtual field trips. motion Amy - second Lavina, all in favor.

Spring Carnival (Barbara): Scheduled for 5/4 from 1:00 – 4:00; working on games and entertainment as well as food trucks. Inviting small business vendors to “buy booth space” and sell their items at the Carnival. Will need 100+ volunteers to support the event.
